I turned the poster making into an art project where students included the elements and principles of art to create their posters. I had one of our school's psychologists/ social workers come and visit my classroom and give a presentation on healthy relationships prior to students creating their posters. Students had to create a fully colored rough draft that had to be approved before creating the actual poster. In each of my 4 classes I chose the top 5 to be voted on by our school's office staff. Artwork was set-up in our conference room for display. I also set up a Google Form where images of the top 5 art pieces from each class were presented. The office staff voted on the best poster from each class section based on the following criteria: Artwork Design, Content/ is the message clear, Craftsmanship/ poster is neat, clean and complete. Winning posters are now put on display in our school's foyer. Winning student's artwork and photos were taken for our yearbook, sent out in our Principals Weekly blog and on school district application that was sent to all families and faculty of our school's community."
